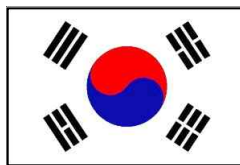

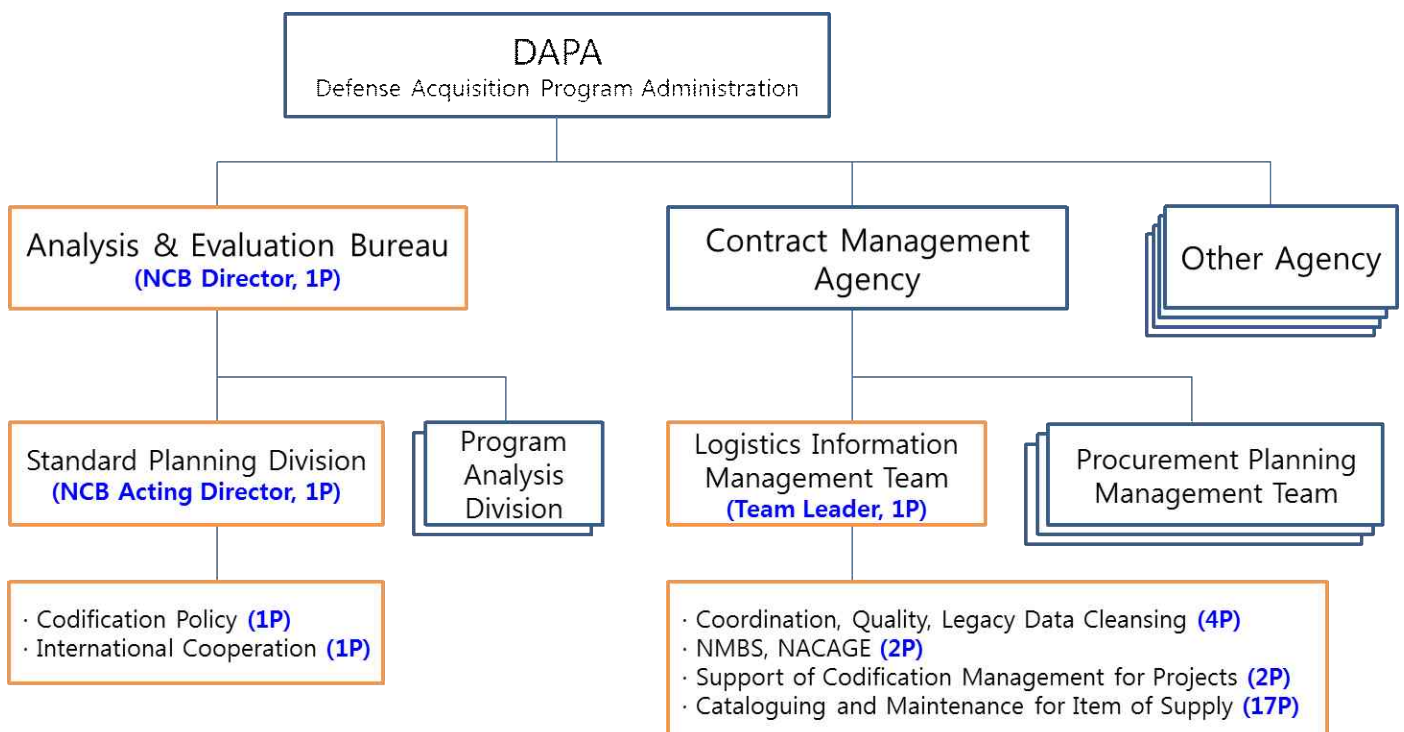
# THE NATIONAL CODIFICATION BUREAU OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA

## AIM :

- To manage the Korean Codification System in conformity with the NATO Codification System(NCS) based on rules and regulations established in AC/135
- To identify and codify items of supply produced by Korean manufacturers and used by military services and NATO countries/sponsored non-NATO countries.
- To maintain a Total Item Record(TIR) that stores all data for each codified item of supply

## ORGANISATION :

- The Korean NCB is responsible for the Korean codification policy and the coordination of all codification activities for the armed services and other organisations.
- Organisationally it is part of the Defense Acquisition Program Administration. The NCB was arranged to be divided into two functional groups (Policy and Cataloging)

- 1988 Establishment of "ADICS" (Automatic Defence Integrated logistic Cataloging System)
- 1999 Development of "DPAMIS"(DPA Management Information System)
- 2001 Implementation of data exchange via NATO Mailbox System
- 2003 Request for the Tier 2 status
- 2005 Sponsored Tier 2 country
- 2006 Changing organization of the NCB(DPA → DAPA)

- 2012 restructuring of the KOR NCB due to the reshuffling of DAPA  
※ Internal change of organizational structure in DAPA
- 2013 Launching new codification tool (KDSIS: Korea Defense Standards Information System)
- 2014 Finished Compliance Test for new codification tool (KDSIS)

## APPLICATION TOOL :

The tool for codifying items of supply according to NATO Codification System rules is **KDSIS** (Korea Defense Standards Information System) developed on our own on April 2013. This system is included in the integrated "Logistic Standard Management System".

## SEGMENTS USED BY THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA :

In addition to input header and output header Item Identification Data are stored in our Codification Management System under the following segments :

- Segment A Identification Data
- Segment B MOE Rule Data
- Segment C Reference Data
- Segment T Cancellation/Delete MOE Rule Data
- Segment V Coded Characteristics Data
- Segment K Item Identification Status/Cancellation Data
